

## **POLICY PROVINCIAL TRAINER**

### **Newfoundland and Labrador**

*1<sup>st</sup> Update – July 2004*

In November 2000, Newfoundland created 8 new Provincial Trainer positions to cover the regions of the province.

To ensure that needs are met for advanced leadership courses, the policy for the appointment and reappointment of Provincial Trainers is set out below.

By review each year, the Leadership Committee can ensure that sufficient numbers of trainers are available.

#### **PROVINCIAL TRAINER APPOINTMENT**

##### Pre-requisites:

- 1 Instructor Trainer (current)
- 2 Teach experience of a minimum of 4 Lifesaving Instructor Courses
- 3 Teach experience of at least one of:
  - 2 Examiner Standards Clinics
  - 2 Lifesaving Instructor Recert Courses
  - 1 NLS Instructor Course
  - 1 AEC Instructor Course

##### Certification process:

Apprentice on at least one complete Instructor Trainer Clinic  
Applications will be invited from selected Instructor Trainers

#### **PROVINCIAL TRAINER REAPPOINTMENT**

1. Individual must have instructed a minimum of two advanced leadership courses in the previous 2 years.
2. Individual must be invited by letter for reappointment as a Provincial Trainer.
3. Individual must be a current Lifesaving Instructor Trainer
